GENERAL RULES

- All leek classes to be judged to CIU rules
- NVS, NDS, NCS BNCS and RHS rules apply to all other classes
- Carnations may be wired
- Once staged, exhibits can only be moved by a steward.
- An exhibitor can enter as many exhibits as he/she wants
- Exhibitors to supply their own vases and containers
- All exhibits to be fresh pulled and washed-with the exception of dressed onions Tops on Parsnips, Carrots & Beetroot to be cut at 4"
- The judges decision will be final
- Any prize may be withheld or modified if the exhibit is considered undeserving of the prize offered
- Exhibits can be staged between 7.00am and 10.00am on Monday the 27th August 2018
- Judging will commence at 10.00am
- The show will be open for viewing at 12.00noon
- Exhibits can be lifted at 8.00pm on Monday 27th August 2018
- Any exhibit remaining after 9.00pm will be disposed of.
- An entry fee of £3.00 will be charged for each leek entry in Class 1. Classes 2-45 entries will be 50p each.
- Baking Competition all entries 25p
- Protest: Any protest must be made to the organisers within one hour of the opening of the show. A protest will only be recognised if it specifically refers to the rules.
- Prize money will be paid out between 7.00 and 8.00pm
- Vases will be provided
